Tour Itinerary

DAY 1 Arrival Danang – City Tour

Meals: Lunch, Dinner
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

Upon arrival at Danang International Airport, meet and greet by the local tour guide. Transfer to a local restaurant for lunch featuring Mi Quang Noodle / Bep Cuon Restaurant. Proceed to visit:

- Marble Mountain – limestone outcrops with caves, pagodas, and panoramic views of Non-Nuoc Beach and the East Sea.
- Son Tra Peninsula (Monkey Mountain) – a former U.S. military base with stunning sea views and the impressive Linh Ung Bai But Pagoda, home to Vietnam's tallest 67m Goddess of Mercy (Lady Buddha) statue.
- Pink Church (Danang Cathedral) and Love Bridge – popular city landmarks.

After dinner at a local seafood restaurant, transfer to hotel for check-in. Overnight in Danang.

DAY 2 Danang – Sun World Ba Na Hills – Danang

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

After breakfast, depart to Sun World Ba Na Hills Mountain Resort (approx. 60 min drive). The package includes:

- **Round-trip cable car ride**
- **Entrance and admission fees to attractions & rides**
- **Funicular ride to the summit**
- **Buffet lunch at a local restaurant in Ba Na Hills**

Explore highlights such as the iconic Golden Bridge, French Village, Fantasy Park, gardens and more. Guests will receive a resort map with attraction details and activity schedules. Return to Danang by 4:00 PM (subject to change). Free at leisure, dinner at own arrangement. Overnight in Danang.

Note: The Dragon Bridge performs fire and water shows every Fri, Sat & Sun at 9:00 PM.

DAY 3 Danang – Hoi An Ancient Town – Danang

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

Morning visit to Cam Thanh Village for a traditional bamboo basket boat ride. Continue to Hoi An Ancient Town (UNESCO World Heritage Site, approx. 45 min drive). Guided walking tour includes:

- **Japanese Covered Bridge**
- **Tan Ky Old House**
- **Fujian Assembly Hall (Phuc Kien Temple)**
- **Museum of Trade Ceramics**

Enjoy free time to explore or shop for handicrafts and Hoi An's signature lanterns. At 4:00 PM, return to Danang. Dinner at own arrangement. Overnight in Danang.
