4D3N | Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam | Travelling Period: Now – September 2026

Tour Highlight

- **Nguyen Hue Street** – District 1's vibrant pedestrian promenade featuring French colonial architecture, the People's Committee, the Rex Hotel, the statue of Uncle Ho Chi Minh, river views, and nearby attractions like the Saigon Opera House and Dong Khoi shopping street.
- **Cafe Apartment Block** – A housing estate turned apartment block now hosting small cafes and uniquely decorated shops. Don't miss it on Nguyen Hue pedestrian street!
- **Cu Chi Tunnels** – The vast underground tunnel network from the 1940s, expanded by Viet Cong guerrilla forces during the American War. Used as hiding places, communications and supply routes, hospitals, and living quarters. Approximately 250 KM stretch from Ho Chi Minh City to the Cambodian border.
- **War Remnants Museum** – Established in 1975, this museum houses harrowing displays of weapons and photographs from the American War, with displays outside of U.S. military hardware including tanks, jets, helicopters, and howitzers.
- **Independence Palace** – Also known as Reunification Convention Hall. Designed by architect Ngo Viet Thu, it was the home and workplace of the President of the Republic of (South) Vietnam and the site of the Fall of Saigon on 30 April 1975.
- **Saigon Central Post Office** – Constructed between 1886 and 1891 with Gothic, Renaissance, and French influences. Its vaulted roof and arched windows are reminiscent of European railway stations.
- **Notre-Dame Cathedral Basilica of Saigon** – Built by French colonists between 1863 and 1880 with two 58-metre bell towers. Features imported materials from France, carved tiles from Marseille, stained-glass windows from the Lorin firm.
- **Saigon Square Market & Ben Thanh Market** – Selling ceramics, clothes, watches, t-shirts, coffee, handbags, shoes, conical hats, custom-made suits and dresses, noodle soup and fruit smoothies.



Tour Itinerary

DAY 1 Arrive Ho Chi Minh City

Meals: Dinner
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

Upon arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, Ho Chi Minh City, the appointed tour guide welcomes guests and proceeds for lunch at a local restaurant. Continue with the Saigon City Tour visiting:

- **War Remnants Museum**
- **Independence Palace**
- **Notre Dame Cathedral**
- **Saigon Central Post Office**
- **Shopping bargains at Saigon Square Market & Ben Thanh Market**

After dinner at a local restaurant, transfer to hotel for check-in. Tour program, tour guide, and transport services end.

DAY 2 Day Trip to Mekong Delta (My Tho + Ben Tre) – Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer to My Tho Marina Pier.
- Cruise on the Tien River and enjoy the scenery of the four islets: Long, Lan, Quy, and Phung. Pass by floating fish farms and view the Rach Mieu Bridge.
- Arrive at Thoi Son Islet: walk along village paths, visit fruit orchards, taste seasonal tropical fruits, and enjoy Southern folk music (Don ca tai tu).
- Take a rowing sampan through shaded canals, visit a honeybee farm to try honey tea & banana wine.
- Continue to Ben Tre: visit a coconut candy workshop and local handicraft villages.
- Motorboat ride along Tan Thach Canal, observe countryside life, then lunch at Viet Nhat Ecological Restaurant. See crocodile & porcupine farms, frog & snake breeding models, relax on hammocks, or enjoy free cycling around fruit orchards, coconut groves, and rice fields.
- Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride through village paths.
- Return to My Tho Pier and transfer back to Ho Chi Minh City.

Dinner today at own arrangement.

DAY 3 Cu Chi Tunnels + Ben Thanh Market – Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
Accommodation: Selected Hotel

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Proceed to Cu Chi Tunnels (~40 KM from city center). Explore the underground tunnel network from the 1940s, expanded by Viet Cong forces during the American War. Experience walking through preserved sections and learn about the wartime history.
- Return to Ho Chi Minh City for lunch.
- Afternoon visit to Ben Thanh Market for bargain shopping.
- Back to hotel, tour program ends.
